In 2006, Architecture 2030 issued the **2030 Challenge**, a breakthrough vision that calls for all new buildings, developments, and major renovations to be carbon neutral by 2030. To support this call to action, AIA created the AIA 2030 Commitment – a national framework with simple metrics and a standardized reporting format – to provide a structure for tracking progress and help firms meet the challenge. To date only one Western Mass. firm has signed on to the Commitment. Learn more about the **2030 Challenge and Commitment** and how your firm can participate. About the Bechtel Environmental Classroom: The Bechtel Building is a combination environmental classroom, meeting space, and field station. It was designed to meet the Living Building Challenge, in accordance with the International Living Building Institute. Supported by a grant from the S. D. Bechtel, Jr. Foundation, Smith College completed the construction of a 2,300 sq.ft. building at the Ada and Archibald MacLeish Field Station in 2012. It was the 5th building anywhere to meet the world's most demanding design and performance-based environmental building standard.
